Current classes are held **online**, with support provided in accessing laptops and internet if needed.

The EPE Program Includes:

- one-on-one and group sessions
 - personal supports
- 6-months post-program support

(focused on successful employment, job maintenance and retention)

- Career Exploration

- Motivation, Confidence, and Self-Esteem
- Life Skills
- Personal and Professional Communication
- Referrals to Counselling & Settlement Services
- Volunteer Placement
