### Services and information

#### **Employment Insurance (EI)**

Employment Insurance (EI) has changed to support more Canadians through the pandemic.

### Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit

Up to 4 weeks of support if you are sick or must self-isolate due to COVID-19.

#### Consult the COVID-19 benefits available to you

Answer questions about your personal situation and find the benefits that may help

#### Canada Emergency Student Benefit (CESB) Closed

The CESB ended on September 30, 2020.

#### Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB)

Income support if you are self-employed or are not eligible for Employment Insurance

### Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy

A wage subsidy for Canadian employers to re-hire workers previously laid off as a result of COVID-19.

#### **COVID-19 Economic Response Plan**

All financial support and services for individuals, businesses, and industries affected by the COVID-19 outbreak.

### Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit

Income support if you must stop work to care for dependents due to closures, high risk and caregiver availability.

#### Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy (CERS)

Rent and mortgage support for qualifying organizations affected by COVID-19.

#### Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB) Closed

The CERB has ended a December 2, 2020. You can no longer apply to, this benefit.












**COVID -19 Emergency Assistance – Government of Ontario**










## Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP)






